








## Covid-19 Summary of Actions

<p>When should my child stay at home?</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All children must attend school unless they are unwell.</li> <li>• If your child has any symptoms of Covid-19, however mild, they should stay at home and book a PCR test.</li> </ul> <p>The symptoms are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ High temperature</li> <li>○ A new continuous cough</li> <li>○ Loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste</li> </ul>
<p>If your child tests positive for Covid-19</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your child needs to isolate and must stay at home for 10 days.</li> <li>• Remote learning will be provided if they are well enough.</li> </ul>
<p>If the rest of the household are fully vaccinated or under 18</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They do not need to isolate, unless they also have symptoms.</li> <li>• They should book a PCR test.</li> </ul>
<p>If a member of the household is over 18 and not fully vaccinated</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They must isolate</li> </ul>
<p>If your child is a close contact of someone who has tested positive for Covid-19</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Close contacts will be contacted by NHS Track and Trace and advised to book at PCR Test.</li> <li>• Book PCR test</li> <li>• Children do not need to stay at home or self-isolate whilst they await the result of the PCR test, unless they have any symptoms of Covid-19.</li> </ul>
