Satisfying and Healthy

Many parents believe that a packed lunch is the healthiest option for their children but it's actually easier to get a child's required nutrients into a cooked school meal. Only 1% of lunch boxes tested meet recommended nutritional standards and a school meal is more likely to sustain a child through the whole day. Children will still be allowed to bring their own packed lunch to school but we suggest you encourage them to try a school meal.

School meals in Somerset are healthy, tasty, and fun!

Pupil Premium

You don't have to be in receipt of benefit to take advantage of a free school lunch. They are available for all infant children. However, schools do receive extra funding for children that come from families on low incomes. This is called Pupil Premium. This money is sent to schools by Central Government based on the numbers of pupils in the school who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). From 2012-13, it has been expanded to include:

- Children who have been eligible for FSM within the last 6 years
- Children whose parents work in the armed forces
- Children in care and adopted children

The pupil premium is worth £1,320 per pupil to your child's school and this money will be used specifically within school to help eligible children reach their full potential, both academically and socially. If you would like to find out how your school uses its pupil premium, please look on their website or speak to your school.
