# Uniform

- Nerrols School jumper or cardigan with school logo
- White shirt (not polo shirt)
- Nerrols School tie (either self-tying or elasticated)
- Grey trousers, skirt or shorts
- Grey or black socks or tights
- Red and white gingham school dress
- Black school shoes (flat, not boots or trainers)
- Nerrols School book bag
